

Xavier is a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the Human Flourishing Program at Harvard's Institute for Quantitative Social Science. Xavier's research interests include ethical issues at the beginning and end of life, conscientious objection, ethical issues in aged care, and pandemic ethics. His recently completed PhD thesis focused on the allocation of lifesaving healthcare resources. Xavier has taught bioethics for several years, and has worked with the Catholic healthcare sector on several projects related to ethics education. In 2020, Xavier was awarded a Fulbright Future Postdoctoral Scholarship, and he was a scholar in residence at Georgetown University's Kennedy Institute of Ethics from September 2021 to March 2022.
